

Safe At School program (SAS)

SAS is a part of the School Health Program (SHP)

Carried out before other programs, BAS, OHP can be done.

Circumstances:

The hygienic situation in most government schools is very poor. The toilets are very old, not well cleanable and not hygienic. The groundwater is not pure because the use of pesticides in agriculture and should be filtered.

SAS Basic:

With the safe at school program, we are trying to create a safe environment in and around school, the minimum is:

- ✓ Water tank on roof of school
- ✓ Sufficient water taps to make it possible to carry out the BAS program
- ✓ Proper water connection to toilets
- ✓ Clean filtered water in water tank and necessary pump and filter.
- ✓ Clean the schoolyard
- ✓ Clean toilets, providing cleaning materials and give instructions.

SAS Plus:

Supplementary suggestions for schoolboard to carry out

- ✓ Well organized school by 5S program:
 - Sort: categorize and classify all materials.
 - Shine: keep it clean and fixed.
 - Setup: put it in the place where it belongs.
 - Standardised: work by standards.
 - Sustain: do maintain

Additional:

- ✓ Clean and sufficient toilets separate for boys and girls.
- ✓ Fence around the school.

Follow up.

Once schools are provided of necessary services, SAS Basic, the manager of DIRDC or MIYO has to check, three times a year, if school is taking care of these services. So, the BAS program can be carried out as expected.
